He previously served as deputy director and director of the LTCI lab in Paris (2009-2016) and as head of the Information science and technology department of Université Paris-Saclay (2016-2017). He received the Grand Prix de la fondation d'entreprise EADS of the French Academy of Sciences in 2013.
